2016 AMERICAN DANCE FESTIVAL TICKETS ON SALE TUESDAY, MAY 3 at 10:00AM

Durham, NC, April 27, 2016—Tickets for the **2016 American Dance Festival (ADF)** season will go on sale **Tuesday, May 3 at 10:00am**. The 2016 ADF celebrates 83 years of presenting, preserving, and promoting modern dance with six and a half weeks of performances that feature some of the most celebrated artists making work today. The season runs **June 16–July 30** and features **61 performances** by **26 companies and choreographers** in **13 different venues**. The season includes the return of festival favorites Pilobolus, Paul Taylor Dance Company, and last season's breakout hit, Company Wang Ramirez, as well as the ADF debuts of Trajal Harrell, Dafi Altabeb, Gabrielle Revlock, and Beth Gill. In all, this season features **5 ADF debuts, 9 ADF commissioned world premieres, and 2 US premieres**.

Performance venues include Durham Performing Arts Center (DPAC), Reynolds Industries Theater, Motorco Music Hall, 21c Museum Hotel, Page Auditorium, Sheaffer Theater, and more. Tickets will be available for purchase in person, by phone, by mail, and online for each venue.

ADF Go is back for its third season. The ADF Go program is designed to make modern dance more accessible and affordable for young arts lovers. Audience members ages 18–30 have the opportunity to purchase a \$10 ticket to most performances in DPAC or Reynolds Industries Theater. ADF Go patrons may purchase online or at the box office and must present a valid ID when picking up tickets.

Tickets are on sale now for **ADF's first ever New York City season, August 1–6 at The Joyce Theater** featuring Tatiana Baganova's Provincial Dances Theatre and Rosie Herrera Dance Theatre. Tickets on sale at <http://bit.ly/1SMYJPJ>.
